- a good work / life balance





The program runs for three days each weekthis may increase to up to five days during work placements.

We will ensure that you receive the ongoing support you need through community links.

Minimbah provides a flexible service — we can offer a social support service, for a fee, in the afternoon or on additional days of the week, depending on individual and family needs.
