NDIS Support Charges

Minimbah charges the prices at the rate shown in each prevailing NDIS Pricing Arrangements and Price Limits for the purposes of developing quotations and the billing of NDIS supports. This summary should be read in conjunction with Minimbah's NDIS Service Agreement.

After Hours Supports

Minimbah provides staff in accordance with the support level requested and agreed to by the participant/nominee and for the hours requested. If a participant arrives late or departs early, Minimbah will still bill for the agreed hours, as staff rosters are unable to be changed at such short notice. From time to time situations occur when a participant may need to be picked up after the agreed time for supports as per the Service Agreement. As Minimbah incurs unrostered staff costs in such instances, Minimbah will bill in 15 minute increments after the agreed support finish time until the participant is pick-ed up (5 min grace period after the scheduled pick-up time).



Paramedic / Hospital Support

A number of Minimbah participants are subject to seizures or other medical conditions that may require urgent paramedic attention. Where hospitalisation is advised by the paramedics, it is often in the best interest of the participant that Minimbah support staff either accompany them in their patient transport vehicle or separately to provide emotional and physical support to the participant until a family member can attend. Minimbah will make every effort to contact the participant's nominee to seek instruction, however, if the matter if urgent and no contact can be made with the nominee and it is considered in the best interest and safety of the participant by the paramedics, a Minimbah support staff member will accompany the participant to the hospital until relieved by a designated family member. The staff time will be billed at the appropriate 1:1 rate as shown above including the time/cost for the staff member to return to Minimbah.

Escalation Periods

From time to time, some of Minimbah's participants will require unscheduled support due to escalations of behaviour to ensure the safety and well-being of themselves, other participants and staff and/or the members of the community. As such times are unpredictable, Minimbah has a duty of care to all to ensure the safety of all persons in the vicinity. Should a situation arise where Minimbah needs to allocate additional unrostered staff resources to such a situation, Minimbah will bill from the participant's NDIS plan the amount of time and resources used that were necessary to create a safe environment for the period of the escalation.

Other NDIS Registered Supports

To ensure opportunities for the delivery of a full range of flexible core supports for participants and their families, Minimbah is registered with the NDIS for a number of supports/registration groups for which prices are not itemised above, as they are only delivered on request and would only serve to further complicate the above list. Minimbah uses the prices as set in the prevailing NDIS Pricing Arrangements and Price Limits for the delivery of such supports. Additional NDIS registration groups include:

- <u>Daily tasks / Shared Living</u> (personal hygiene activities, or supervision of personal daily tasks; which support a participant to live as independently as possible at home, and in the community
- Assistance with Travel/Transport (to build capacity to independently travel)
- <u>Assistance with Personal Activities</u> (assistance with a range of everyday activities in your home, supporting you to learn the skills needed to be as independent as possible, showering, dressing, grooming, etc.)
- <u>Personal Activities High</u> (assistance with daily personal activities at/from home, higher support needs High Intensity/support requirements)
- Assistance with access to and maintaining employment (assistance to build work-related skills to find and maintain employment)
- <u>Development of Life Skills</u> (assist the development of everyday life skills to assist
 you to live as independently as possible budgeting skills, meal planning, social
 network building, literacy and numeracy, health & wellbeing, etc.)

Daily Activity Fee	\$4.50/day/participant
To avoid excessive administrative costs and time, Minimbah has averaged	
out the non-NDIS costs associated with general activity supplies and	
special occasion supplies for all participants. This takes into account the	
need for Minimbah and our participants to be flexible in the manner in	
which these activities, etc can be delivered. General activity supplies	
include (but not limited to) all cooking material (food and equipment);	
craft supplies, art supplies, games, outing equipment, exercise	
equipment, bikes, ipads, computers, music and musical instruments,	
drama supplies, vegetable and herb garden and sensory materials, special	
events such as animal farms visits, music groups, etc, special holiday and	
participant birthday events – Easter, Christmas, Mothers Day, Fathers	
Day, Australia Day, Halloween, Melbourne Cup Day, Valentines Day, etc	
(food and decorations, etc).	
PARTICIPANT TRANSPORT	
Minimbah has a fleet of 10 vehicles (as at October 2022) that have been	
modified for disability access that are used for group and 1:1 transport (6	
Mercedes Sprinter vans and 4 Imax vans). This includes transport for	
outings and activities, as well as for providing drop-off and pick-up	
services within the local area, where requested. This is a non-NDIS	
support cost and can either be funded privately or where applicable	
through a participant's NDIS Core Supports.	
As of 1 st March 2020, the NDIA now allows participant activity based	
transport vehicle costs (not the support costs or to/from primary	
residence) to be drawn from a participant's core support budget, if they	
have sufficient funds and choose to do so.	
Minimbah's charges are based on a cost recovery calculation of the	
vehicle including insurance, fuel, maintenance, depreciation , etc.	
Vans: If group transport is required for activities and outings	\$20/trip/day/participant
	(excludes 1:1 transport)
Vans: If 1:1 transport is required	\$2.76/km; min \$15/trip.
Where a van is required for 1:1 sole participant transport, the cost will be	
quoted, irrespective of whether funded through core supports or	
privately.	
Minimbah also offers a number of other specific community activities	Prices available on
such as the Easter Show, and other events, etc. which need to incorporate	request
externally set costs, as well as the transport. These will be quoted when	
they become available and all prices known.
